The St. Ignace Planning Commission met publicly on Friday 13 November, 2020 to review the site at Dock 3 Park where City Council has expressed the desire to rezone a portion of the recreational property to waterfront light industrial. Stakes had been placed to demarcate the new desired property lines.

Planning Commission members present were: Rachel Conant, Luke Paquin, Cindy Snyder, John Kling, Rick Perry and Betsy Dayrell-Hart, meeting conditions for a quorum. Others present were Mr. Fullerton (and Mr. Paquin) representing City Council, Code Enforcement Officer Kyle Mulka, Building Inspector Brian Olsen, representatives of the Arnold Freight Company, and a reporter from the St. Ignace News. There was a motion by John Kling to recommend rezoning of the demarcated property from Recreational to WLID, seconded by Luke Paquin, discussion and a vote. The Planning Commission voted 4-2 for the motion.

A Public Hearing will be held on December 21st from 5-7 PM. The meeting will be virtual due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, and the City Manager will make arrangements for the meeting, and for people who can not attend virtual meetings to otherwise have their comments heard and to hear the discussions during the meeting. A Public Notice will be posted in the St. Ignace News and at City Hall, and the notice will also be listed in the Planning Commission on-line post at the St. Ignace Public Library.

Mr. Fullerton will be responsible to notify the St. Ignace News to post notice of the Public Hearing.
