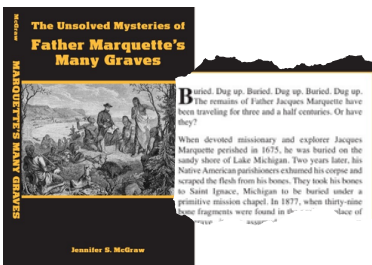

Northern climate gardening info for best yields, and compost 101 to complete the cycle. Get an early start on this summer's garden!



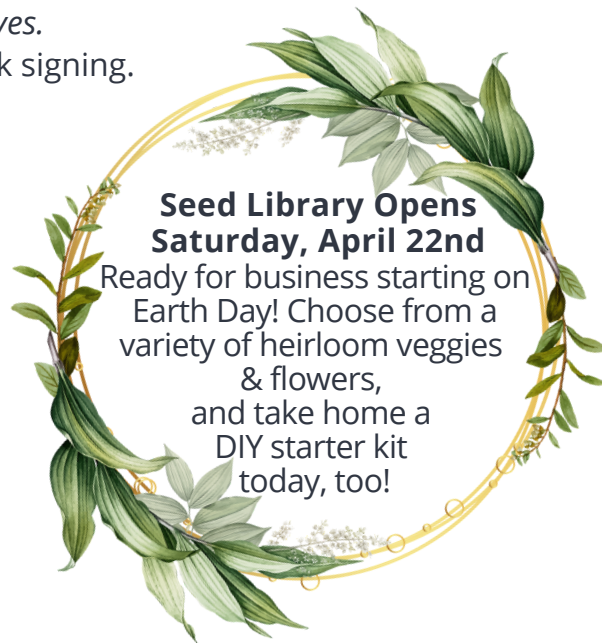
Poets' Space Friday, April 14th, 6:30 PM
